KS1 Kingfisher	What were castles like in the Forest of Dean and its surrounding areas?	How have toys changed over time?	How has flight changed over time?
Nightingale Sparrow	Pupils learn about why and where castles were built, the key features of castles, the different roles of people in castles and explore castles in our local area.	Pupils explore how toys have changed over time. We look at toys from the Victorian era, toys that our grandparents and parents played with and toys that we might play with now.	Pupils learn about significant individuals who have contributed to international achievements linked to flight and how flight has changed over time.

Jay Swift	Pupils will learn about the story of the Forest of Dean from the Roman period up until the industrial revolution. They will build up their knowledge of chronology over time and will become more familiar with the history of their local area.	Pupils will continue their learning on the history of the Forest of Dean and will focus on the industrial revolution. They will look at how this had an impact on the local area and significant changes in England during this period.	Pupils will understand the role the British monarchy has played in history and today, touching on significant monarchs and periods in history where monarchy impacted our country greatly.
UKS2 Woodpecker Heron Peregrine	What similarities and differences are there between the challenges faced by the Maya civilisation and England from the 8 th to 10 th century?	Which ancient civilisation contributed the most to the modern world?	What were the greatest achievements of the Ancient Egyptians?
	In contrast to our study of the chronology of British History, we look at the Mayan Civilisation. We compare and contrast it with what was happening in Britain at the time as well as looking at the mysterious disappearance of the Maya!	After studying the Ancient Maya, we will be exploring several other ancient civilisations (Ancient Sumer; The Indus Valley;The Shang Dynasty of Ancient China), discovering their likenesses and how their inventions and achievements have impacted the modern world.	After looking at the achievements of a range of early civilizations, we will focus our study on looking in depth at Ancient Egypt and consider what the greatest achievements of the Ancient Egyptians were.
