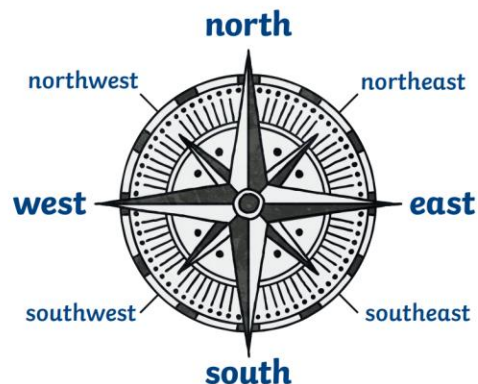

Technical vocabulary

Physical Feature	Features of a landscape that are naturally occurring (eg. rivers)
Human Feature	Features of a landscape that are made by man (eg. roads, buildings)
Geology	geology is the study of the physical features and history of Earth

Journey and Features

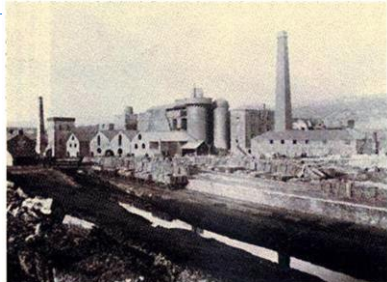
- The Forest of Dean is rich with coal and iron ore reserves.

Sketch Maps

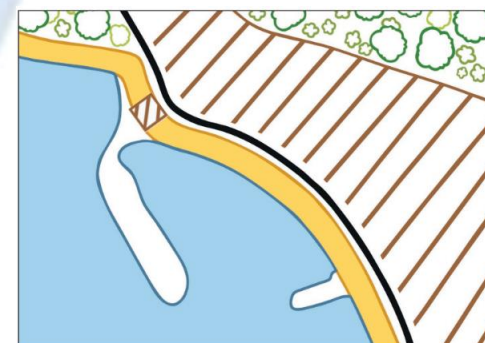
- Taken from an aerial view
