They will engage with Jewish artefacts, the creation story, and the customs of Shabbat to see how Jewish people express their faith.		Who do Christians say made the world? Explore the 'big story' and the story of creation from Genesis.	Why does Easter matter to Christians? Explore the traditions of Easter and key Christian symbols.	What does it mean to belong to a faith community? Christians. Explore how people show their love for each other and how this is show towards God.	What makes some places sacred to believers? Investigate sacred places of worship for Judaism and Christianity.

Identify links between the story of Pentecost and Christian beliefs about the 'kingdom of God' on Earth.	How and why do people try to make the world a better place? Identify some differences in how people put their beliefs into action and make links between religious teachings and the world we live in.

Make connections between Gospel texts, Jesus' 'good news', and how Christians live in the Christian community.	How do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people? Explore and understand that everyone has different beliefs and celebrate everyone's opinion.	What matters most to Humanists and Christians?
