Technical vocabulary	
Special person	A person who you care about and is special to you.
Family	A group of people or person who loves and cares for you.
Friendship	People you enjoy and choose to spend time with.
Care	How you should treat and look after other people.
Community	A community is a group of people who have something in common, like going to the same school.
Unique	How everyone is different and special to each other.

Trusted adults

We will learn that trusted adults are people we can turn to turn to in times of worry, stress or crisis.

We will identify who may be trusted adults and explain when we may need to talk to a trusted adult.

Different families

We will be learning that families may look different for each person.

We will also be learning that it is important to celebrate and respect these differences.
