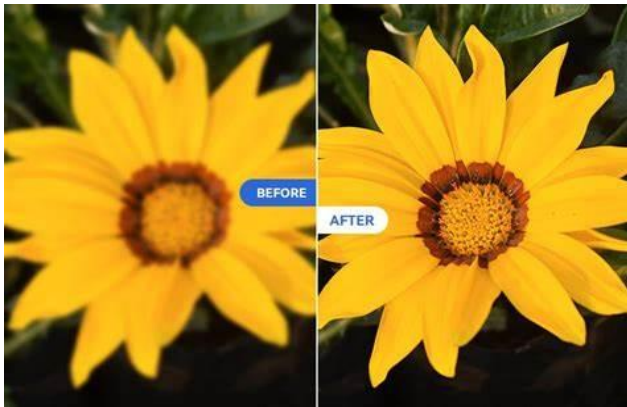
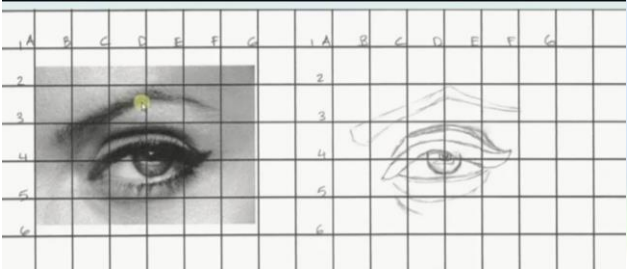
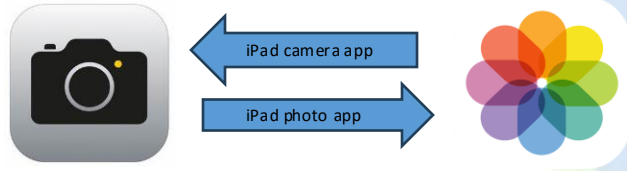

### Technical vocabulary

Sketching	A quick drawing of something.
Photography	A photograph is an image, or picture, that has been captured on film or some other material. People who take pictures are called photographers.
Mixed media	Mixed media art is when an artist combines a mixture of different materials to create their work. The materials used can be anything, like paint, paper, cardboard, photographs, found objects, things from nature, and more.
Botany	The study of plants.
Observational drawing	Drawing exactly what you see.
Realism	Realism artists paint everyday subjects and people, and tried to depict the real world exactly as it appears.
Focus	The area of the photo that is most sharp (you can see most clearly).
Contemporary art	The work of artists who are living in the twenty-first century.
Negative space	The empty space around and between the subject of an image.
