EYFS	Children will learn to play together with other children. They will learn to initiate conversation with other children and adults. Children will learn to understand the feelings of others. Year A Year 1 & 2	<b>TEAM</b> This unit is inspired by the idea that if a team works well together, it has a positive impact on all of its members and what they can achieve.	<b>It's my body</b> The It's My Body unit explores choices that children can make about looking after their bodies.	<b>Aiming high</b> In this unit of work children will learn about having high aspirations.	<b>Britain</b> Children will learn about the benefits of being part of a community.	<b>Money Matters</b> This unit encourages children to think about where money comes from and how it can be used.	<b>Be yourself</b> This unit is inspired by the idea that having confidence to 'be yourself' can have a positive impact on mental health and emotional wellbeing.
Year B Year 1 & 2	<b>Think Positive</b> This unit is designed to help children recognise, talk about and accept their feelings, both positive and negative, as well as how to manage certain emotions.	<b>One world</b> Children will learn about people living in different places to us and their ways of life.	<b>Safety first</b> Children will learn about everyday dangers, in the home and outside and how they can keep themselves safe. Children will also learn about the Internet and how to stay safe online.	<b>Respecting rights</b> This unit is based on the concept that we should all be rights respecting citizens in our communities.	<b>VIPS</b> This unit explores the Very Important Persons (VIPs) in the children's lives and the ways in which they can develop positive relationships with them.	<b>Growing Up</b> This topic is an introduction to how we grow and change, both physically and emotionally. Children will learn about their own and others' bodies, looking at similarities and differences in people.
Year A Year 3 & 4	<b>Team</b> In this unit children will learn how to work well as a team. They will learn about how their actions can have a positive impact on others and how their actions have an impact on their team.	<b>Aiming High</b> This unit focusses on goals and aspirations. Children will identify what they have accomplished so far and what helped them to succeed.	<b>Be yourself</b> This unit is inspired by the idea that it is important to have confidence to be yourself. It aims to enable children to identify their strengths and achievements.	<b>Britain</b> This unit is inspired by the idea that we live in a diverse, multicultural and democratic society and that this is important and brings many benefits	<b>Money Matters</b> This unit aims to encourage children to think about where money comes from and how it can be used.	<b>It's my body</b> This unit, entitled It's My Body, explores the choices children can make about looking after their bodies.

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Year B Year 3 & 4	<p><b>Think Positive</b></p> <p>Children will think about their feelings, both positive and negative and how our attitude towards life can affect our mental health. Children will learn about positive thinking</p>	<p><b>VIPs</b></p> <p>Children will learn about friendships, how friendships are formed and maintained, and the qualities of a good friend. Children will learn about how to deal with disputes with their friends and bullying.</p> <p>Children will learn about Health and Safety - including food allergies</p>	<p><b>Respecting Rights</b></p> <p>Children will learn about human rights. It helps children to explore the ideas of equality and discrimination and the consequences of both.</p>	<p><b>One World</b></p> <p>Children will learn what it is like to live in another country / culture. They will explore the differences and similarities. They will learn about how their own actions can have a positive and negative effect on people in other countries.</p>	<p><b>Safety First</b></p> <p>In this unit of work, children will consider what it means to take responsibility for their own safety. Children will learn about e-Safety, considering what should never be shared and how to report any concerns about online incidents.</p>	<p><b>Growing up</b></p> <p>This topic builds on children's knowledge of the human body; how we grow and change, both physically and emotionally. They will learn about the roles of males and females in human reproduction, how babies are made and how they are born. They will also learn about different relationships and family structures.</p>
Year A Year 5 & 6	<p><b>Team</b></p> <p>Children will: Talk about the skills and qualities needed for a good team. They will learn how to work effectively together and how to build success.</p>	<p><b>Aiming High</b></p> <p>Children will learn about their own achievements and what helped them to achieve. They will consider their own learning styles and what helps them to learn. They will also look at how they can overcome their own barriers to learning.</p>	<p><b>Be yourself</b></p> <p>Children will develop a positive view of themselves and recognise the importance of being proud of being an individual.</p>	<p><b>Britain</b></p> <p>This unit is inspired by the idea that Britain represents a wide range of faiths and ethnicities and that the structures within it are there to support all. Children will learn how they can make a positive contribution to the community.</p>	<p><b>Money matters</b></p> <p>Children will develop their understanding of how money is used in the wider world.</p>	<p><b>It's my Body</b></p> <p>In this unit of work, children will learn about how to take care of their bodies. Children will also learn about the importance of sleep and keeping clean, especially as their bodies change during puberty.</p>

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<p>Year B Year 5 &amp; 6</p>	<p><b>Think Positive</b> Children will develop their understanding of thoughts, emotions and having a positive attitude.</p>	<p><b>VIPs</b> Children will understand the importance of respecting others and how to respond to different opinions. They will develop their understanding about how to make good choices.</p>	<p><b>Respecting Rights</b> Children about human rights and understand that human rights apply to everyone across the world. Explain how to respect other people's rights and why this is important.</p>	<p><b>One World</b> Children will understand how to be responsible global citizens. They will learn about current issues that are affecting our world and how to make choices that help to make the world a better place.</p>	<p><b>Safety First</b> Children will: Know how to take responsibility for their own safety and how to assess risk. They will learn how to behave responsibly online.</p>	<p><b>Growing up</b> Children will: Describe the changes peoples bodies go through during puberty and how we can look after our changing bodies. They will describe the process of human reproduction from conception to birth.</p>
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
