

#### What should I already know?

Years 3 and 4

Different voices and instruments are used in periods of music

Musicians use music to express themselves, to communicate and to entertain themselves and others.

#### 1140

O Euchari Hildegard von Bingen Early Period

Tells the story of St Eucharius.

#### 1741

Hallelujah from Messiah Handel **Baroque Period** 

> Major sounding (happy/joyful)

**Tropical Bird** Trinidad Steel Band Calypso Caribbean

Syncopated rhythms Steel pans

Night on a Bare Mountain Mussorgsky Romantic

Russian composer Based on traditional folk song and stories Written for symphony orchestra Describes witches dancing throughout the night

#### 1867

Trumpets, trombones, saxophones, drums, bass, piano Form of music AABA

#### 1964


I Got You (I Feel Good) James Brown Funk

Upbeat tempo Strong off-beat rhythms Lively horn section Punchy vocals

### 1808

Symphony No. 5 Beethoven Classical Period

Uses instruments of the orchestra (strings, wind, brass, percussion)



Bhabiye Akh Larr Gayee **Bhujhangy Group** Bhangra - Punjab/UK

Started as a folk dance - time of the harvest.

Combines traditional Asian sounds with modern Western musical instruments and influences. Guitar, banjo and accordion as well as dhol, tumbi and dholak.

Sahela Re Kishori Amonkar North Indian Classical - India

Leading vocalists of Indian Classical Music in the 20th century Emphasises the spiritual

#### 1995

Wonderwall Oasis 90s Indie

Influenced by The Beatles Melodic, guitar-based music

#### 2008

Jai Ho from Slumdog Millionaire A.R. Rahman 21st century music

Film music Draws a range of cultural traditions


