Re: Forest Schools & Allotment

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to be able to tell you that the school is able to, once again, run allotment, outdoor learning and forest school sessions this academic year.

This year, the allotment sessions will be run by Mrs Self. We will continue to send weekly reminders to classes about their allotment sessions and they will be on the weekly update on Fridays, but please do put the timetable below on your fridge too!

Not only do we learn in the classroom at St White's but each class will also get a block of either Outdoor Learning or Forest Schools to carry on learning outside. These sessions will follow similar activities and will need the same equipment. Children enjoy the freedom to explore and experience the natural world in all seasons and all weathers (except thunder and lightning or very high winds). They will be working towards completing the National Outdoor Learning Award (NOLA) by the time they reach year 6. The Outdoor Learning sessions will be run by Mrs Fernandes and the Forest Schools sessions will be run by Mr Brown.

Set out on the last page is the timetable to show when Outdoor Learning, Forest Schools and allotment are due to take place over the year.

The safety and welfare of the pupils participating in Outdoor Learning, Forest School and allotment sessions is paramount, and therefore all tasks are age-appropriate and risk assessments have been carried out for all activities. The clothing that the children wear is also extremely important. Outdoor Learning and Forest Schools will take place in all weathers, other than high winds and/or thunder and lightning. A safety sweep is done before every session so that we can ensure that the site is safe even if it is wet. To ensure that all children are able to access the sessions fully, please ensure that your child(ren) have the required clothes in school for every session (see below). The school will provide waterproof coats and trousers for all children to wear when it is necessary. If the correct clothes are not in school your child(ren) will spend the afternoon in the school building completing work left by their class teacher. If you have any issues with getting the clothing your child requires, please do not hesitate to come into school to see us about it.

























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Essential Equipment: Clothing (for adults and children)

Please ensure that your child has the following items of clothing for the particular times of the year for their Forest School sessions. As previously mentioned, children will not be able to take part in the sessions if they do not have the appropriate clothing to protect them from the weather and from cuts, scrapes and stings. Adults and children must wear long sleeves tops and trousers at all times. Layering clothing is the best way to keep warm and adjust to suit their temperature. We do provide children with waterproof clothing to put over their clothes but please do be aware that your child may still come home with mud on their clothes.

As with all uniform, please make sure that **EVERYTHING IS LABELLED!**

Finally, in order for your child to take part in Forest Schools, the school must have an up to date completed medical form for them. If there have been any changes to your child's medical needs this year, please do contact the school office so that medical forms can be updated. Before each class has their Outdoor Learning or Forest Schools sessions, a consent and medical update form will be sent out to all parents. These must be completed and returned before the start of each group of sessions.
