



### What should I already know?

- Christianity = A religion where its followers believe and follow the teachings of the son of God.

### Technical vocabulary

Gospel texts	The first four books in the Bible, written by Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
narrative	Written accounts of connected events.
parable	Stories used to teach a moral lesson.
teaching	Lessons Jesus told His disciples are important.
moral	Concerned with what is right and wrong.

### Building strong foundations

- Jesus' incarnation is 'good news' for all people. 'Gospel' means 'good news'.
- The good news Jesus has spread after his incarnation (coming back to life) and how Christians decide to live their lives from his teachings.
- Those who follow what Jesus said have built firm foundations. This can mean trusting God, praying humbly, giving generously, forgiving and accepting forgiveness, loving yourself and neighbour.

### How do Christians show what Jesus would do from a healing miracle.

Shows compassion: Jesus responds to the Centurion's request with kindness and is willing to help, even though the Centurion isn't one of the Jewish people.

Heals with authority: Jesus demonstrates that He has the power to heal, even from a distance, simply by speaking the word.

Values faith: Jesus praises the Centurion's faith, showing that belief in Jesus' power to heal is important.

Brings hope: By healing the servant, Jesus shows that God's power can bring healing and restoration to anyone who believes, regardless of their background.

### The Sermon on the Mount

- Christians see that Jesus' teachings and examples are different to expectations - The Sermon on the Mount is an example of this, where Jesus' values go towards the weak and vulnerable.

### How does prayer teach Christians how to live their lives?

4 main components of prayer:

Praise: Saying good things about God (e.g., "God, you are amazing because you made the world").

Confession: Admitting when we've done something wrong (e.g., "I'm sorry for being unkind").

Asking: Requesting help for ourselves or others (e.g., "Please help my friend who is sick").

Thanksgiving: Saying thank you to God (e.g., "Thank you for my family").
