What should I already know?

- Christians believe in God
- The **Bible** contains stories about God and Jesus
- The **Bible** teaches us about **forgiveness**, which means to stop feeling angry over things have been done to us.

What is the good news that Jesus brings

- **Gospel** means 'good news'
- The gospel in the Bible is mainly written in four books
 - The Gospel of Matthew,
 - The Gospel of Mark,
 - The Gospel of Luke
 - The Gospel of John.
- The good news Jesus brings is **Christians** finding peace and **forgiveness** through the actions of Jesus.

Understanding how Christians say sorry and worship

- **Forgiveness** is very important for **Christians**.
- **Forgiveness** from God is good news for **Christians** as this means they will be able to enter heaven.
- **Forgiveness** is so important to **Christians** that it is included in the Lord's Prayer.
- As well as the Lord's Prayer, **Christians** can also say sorry to God and ask for **forgiveness** through **confession**.

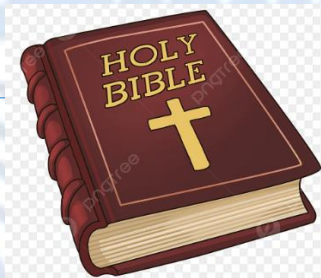

Key features of a church

Church helps Christians remember the ways in which Jesus' life and teaching offers them 'good news'. They can always find friendship, peace and forgiveness in Church.

Technical vocabulary

Christian	Someone who follows Christianity and worships God
Church	The sacred building for Christians
Bible	The Holy Book read by Christians which contains stories about God and Jesus
Gospel	The record of Christ's life and teaching in the first four books of the New Testament. Means good news.
Forgiveness	Not to feel angry over actions done to us. God's promise not to count our sins against us.
Peace	Taking action to restore a broken situation. The state of being free from disturbance or worry.
Sins	An immoral act seen to be going against God
Confession	The act of admitting your mistakes to God. Catholics practice confession.
