

## Science

### Evolution and Inheritance

Children will learn how humans and animals have adapted over time. They will learn about which characteristics are inherited.

## History

### Vikings

Children will explore the history of the Vikings and explore how they can be seen as raiders, traders or explorers.

## Geography

Children will understand the Earth's structure and how tectonic plates shape the surface of Earth. They will also learn the causes of earthquakes, volcanoes, and tsunamis, and identify where tectonic activity is most common.

## Art

### Portraits

With a focus on art-work created by Jean-Micheal Basquiat and Leonardo da Vinci, children will be honing their sketching skills and understanding of anatomy to create a self-portrait.

## PE

**Tag Rugby:** Pupils develop their understanding of attacking and defending principles in order to outwit their opponents.

**Dance:** Pupils develop different styles of dance whilst looking at the historical culture and origins of dance.

## DT

Children are designing and sewing a tablet or book cover. The children will look at a range of stitches to join fabric including appliquéing designs onto them.

## English

In English this term we are going to building our skills in narrative writing. Developing our use of dialogue and how to move a story on through speech.

We will also be continuing our project group work over the term to help make a positive change to the community.

## Maths

### Decimals, Fractions and Percentages (Year 6)

Children will become confident turning fractions into decimals and know how to find a percentage of a number.

### Multiplication (Year 5)

Children will build on their multiplication skills in order to multiply 2 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers.

## Computing

### Fact File databases

Children will learn to use a database to order data and create charts to answer questions.

Children will learn to answer questions by using spreadsheets to organise and calculate data.

## Music

Children will be developing their understanding of pitch, tempo and dynamics through singing, appraising and playing the recorder. Children will explore folk music, including sea shanties, and become more skilled with the recorder.

## PSHE

### First Aid

Children will learn what to do in an emergency, the different types of bites and stings, the implications of asthma and how to help when someone is bleeding.

### County Lines

Children will understand how criminal gangs use grooming and manipulation to exploit young people, teaching them to recognise warning signs of exploitation and know who they can turn to for help and support in a safe, age-appropriate way
