Develop your creativity:

- ◆ Create a bottle orchestra – can you use it to play your favourite tune?
- ◆ Design and make a set of noise blocking ear muffs using recycled packaging and scraps of material (such as old clothes)
- ◆ Create a musical instrument – can you get it to make different pitch sounds? Use it to accompany your favourite song.

- ◆ Write a poem by thinking about lots of different sounds. You could use alliteration or onomatopoeia in your poem too.
- ◆ Write a story that starts with this first sentence. "It was a quiet night when the loudest noise anyone had ever heard shook the whole town."
- ◆ Create a calligram (shape) poem using different sounds. Perhaps the louder sounds could be bigger and the quieter sounds smaller.
